- Forensic low secure service for males
- Primarily the personality disorder pathway
- Fluctuating bedstate

Before the project...

- Was a stand alone trust.
- In 2015 the decision was made to close whalley services under the transforming care agenda
- Service users and staff were informed with very little information about the future or where their home would be.
- Co-production
- Service user compatibility became a major concern
- Service users who previously engaged at high levels were observed to be withdrawing.
- Physical intervention on Maplewood 3 increased due to anxieties around moving into community services
 - "What's the point if it's closing?"

Welcome box...

- When a service user arrives to the ward a "welcome box" is waiting in their bedroom
- It includes information on their key team members and the ward, toiletries and some little treats
- A number of service users come into the service with very little.
- "it made me feel welcomed"
- "I was worried about coming onto the ward but it was nice"

- OTA has recently returned to the ward after long term sickness
- Introduce the ward staff interest checklist around activities
- Continue to support the service users throughout transition into community services
- Support staff members throughout the service changes


